In spite of lockdown during the pandemic situation following events were completed successfully:

1. Digital Poster Making Competition

On the occasion of International Environment Day, on 5th June 2020, Rotaractors conducted Intercollegiate Digital Poster Making Competition from 1st June 2020 to 5th June 2020. The aim of this event was to spread message and awareness about our environment through the digital posters. It was theme-based event. Three themes were given three themes named as Future of Nature, Threats to Environment and Best Practices for Environment.

Total 55 students from various colleges participated in this event.

2. PowerPoint Presentation Competition on “Life after Covid-19”

To create awareness about the effect of COVID-19 over the different aspects of Life's of people, a PowerPoint Presentation Competition was organised on on7th June 2020 “**Life after Covid-19**”. Participants had to make PPT on the topic with audio (to explain their presentation) and submit it on the given link. **33** participants from various colleges took part in this competition.

3. The Riddle Master Quiz Competition”

It was fun event which was designed with difficulty levels; from easy to hard. During lockdown to engage students in various activites where brain power is involved the riddle master event was organised from 8th June 2020 To 12th June 2020 at 5 PM Everyday which can be played with friends, solve the riddle and win.

5 different quizzes were prepared for each day.:1) Robust Quiz 2) Emoji Quiz 3) Who Am I? 4) Guess The Gibberish 5) Logic Builder

The organisers received around 370 participants from 13 different states of India including west Bengal and Nagaland. It was a great experience for the Rotaractors. All those participants who had scored at least 50% marks were awarded with participation certificates and Top ten winners of our Riddle Masters were awarded with Riddle Master Certificates.

4. Webinar on Yoga Day:

On the Occasion of International Yoga Day 21 June 2020, online Yoga session was conducted by Rotaractor Mr.Sunil Mahala, a Professional Yoga Trainer. Total 47 participants enrolled in this session.

5. Poem Writing Competition:

To celebrate Doctor's Day (1 July, 2020) , to appreciate their work for the society , Poem Writing Competition was conducted on theme "**Doctor's Day - CORONA WARRIORS**" on 26 June, 2020 to 29 June 2020 in three languages Hindi, Marathi and English. **38** responses were received from various colleges from India. 7. Webinar on "How to Excel in Interview"

This is joint project conducted with "Rotaract Club of Bombay Film City" on 28th June 2020

From our club **10** Rotaractors actively participated in the project. Through this webinar **Ms. Reba Coelho** the speaker of the event educated everyone about an interview. He spoke on the important skills required to crack the interviews also various tips and advice were given.

8. Webinar On Awareness on Population Day

On the occasion of population Day on 11th July 2020, a webinar on “**Awareness on Population Day**” was organised. Dr. Nileema Inamdar (Gynaecologist) was the chief speaker. She guided students on (a) How population effect on earth (b) Why family planning is must (c) Why we should be open about sex education (d) myth and misconceptions about sex.etc. **72** participants (including two teacher in-charge) actively participated in this webinar and asked queries during question answer session and made it more interactive.

9. Story Telling Competition

To develop speaking skills and instil confidence among the students, an online Story Telling Competition was organised from 20th July 2020 to 25th July 2020. 15 students from various colleges actively participated and shared their stories. Mr. Yogendra More from Rohindas Patil Management Studies, Mumbai won the first prize.

10. Webinar on "Mensuration Cup and Hygiene":

Webinar on "**Mensuration Cup and Hygiene**" was organised jointly with Rotaract Club of M. L. Dahanukar College on 27th July 2020.

The main objective of the webinar was to create awareness about the use of the menstrual cup and how it can be more beneficial for all the females rather than using sanitary napkins. Speaker Ms. Sharvari Deodhar guided the participants about the precautions to be taken while using the cup and hygiene measures to be followed. **226** students from various colleges participated in this webinar.

11. "Talk Show with Berude Seth" :

A "**Talk Show with Berude Seth**" was jointly organised along with Rotaract Club of Mumbai Dahisar, on 1st August 2020, where **446** students participated. The webinar put light on the journey of Mister Berude Seth from Borivali to Silicon Valley as a successful businessman and an entrepreneur. In the webinar he shared his life experience and difficulties which inspired the participants. D.G Sunil Mehra was the Chief Guest and Guest of Honour was Dr. Rtr. Ojas Joshi for this event.

12. Mask Making Competition:

On the occasion of Independence Day, we had organized the “**Mask Making Competition**” from 13th August to 15th August 2020. Where participants upload the image of mask made by them, many have learned from this activity how to make the mask. **13** students from various colleges participated actively. 13. Webinar on " Eye Care":

An essay writing competition on **"Skin Donation- A Brief and its importance"** was organised jointly with Rotary Club of Mumbai West Coast, Rotaract Club of Delhi Shahdara RID-3012 and Rotaract Club of Cotton City Raichur RID-3160 on 29th August to spread the awareness about Skin Donation.

15. PCOS Awareness campaign:

A webinar on **"PCOS Awareness campaign"** was organised jointly on 5th September 2020 with Rotaract Club of Mumbai Wadala East. It was organised for girls, where **16** Rotaractors from our club actively participated. Dr. Sheetal Suryavanshi, (Gynaecologist, infertologist, and Nutrients and Endocrine specialist) briefed the participants about POLYCYSTIC OVARY SYNDROME (PCOS) , its symptoms, causes, treatment and precautions.

16. Webinar on " Financial Literacy":

A webinar on **Financial Literacy was organised** on 8th September 2020 on the occasion of **World Literacy Day**. The objective of the webinar was to literate people about finance and benefits of saving. This was an opportunity given to Rotaractor Akash Sahani who is Director of Entrepreneur Cell of the club and CFO of India Edith Pt. Ltd. 4 faculty members and **56** students from various colleges actively participated and made the event successful.

17. Webinar on "Youth and Suicide":

A webinar on "Youth and Suicide" was organised on 10th September 2020 on the occasion of "World Suicide Prevention Day" to help the people and to clear their misconceptions. The objective of the workshop was co-ordinate with psychiatrist instead of taking any wrong step in life better to talk about our problems and situations.. Dr Gaurav Kulkarni (MD psychiatrist) was the speaker of the event. 8 faculty members and **112** students from different colleges actively participated and made this event successful.

18. Webinar on "Effect of Current Pandemic on Mental Health"

A webinar was organised on **29th September 2020** on the topic "Effect of Current Pandemic on Mental Health".

4 faculty members and **63** students from various colleges attended the webinar and asked their queries in question answer session. A well experienced and practising Gynaecologist Dr. Nileema Inamdar conducted very informative session on the topic. She spoke on effects of emotional and mental changes humans have to face from stress and anxiety because of the ongoing pandemic. She also spoke on the solutions as well as precautions to be taken on this issue.

19. Quiz on Mahatma Gandhiji:

An online quiz was conducted on the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti on 2nd October 2020 . Its objective was to honour Freedom Fighter Mahatma Gandhi by recalling him and his contribution to the nation on his birth anniversary. In this quiz **68** participants from various colleges attended the quiz.

An orientation program for self-finance and commerce section was conducted on 9th October 2020 and 21st October 2020 respectively. To understand what is Rotaract Club, benefits of the orientation and how it works was explained in the orientation.

21. E-Quiz on World Student's Day”

22. Garba Dress Competition:

To celebrate Navratri, an online Garba dress Competition was organised on 26th October 2020. **13** participants from various colleges submitted their videos of performing Garba of 2-3 minutes and a photo in Garba attire.
